#### **Review of "Towards Professional Grid Certification" draft document**

This item was discussed first as Rüdiger had to leave to call early. Rüdiger had circulated a document [ref email with subject "[et-cg] Draft Recommendation" on Thu, 26 Apr 2007) which was discussed and comments solicited. The following points were raised

1. We should be careful of the language used as terms such as "Engineer" have specific meanings in some countries. For example, in the UK the UK Engineering Council certifies University courses for Engineers. Our courses are aimed at in-service professional training which is a different audience. We may need to change term to e.g. Certified Grid Professional.
2. Professional certifications should be set in context with academic courses and qualifications as part of a continuum of education/training.

**ACTION** Kathryn Cassidy: Ensure that this document uses terms from the glossary consistently and that the glossary contains all relevant terms from the document.

#### **Development of National & International Training & Education Policy**
