2 F2F preparation

- Ellen explains OGSA teleconference conclusions.
- Ellen: one of the things that we need is to get is the OGSA-WG comfortable that CIM is a good direction. Need to get a scenario and/or use-case, identify what types of information are needed, then bring in how GLUE, CIM etc. might address that. We need to make it concrete and real.
- Tom Roney: the DMTF and CIM is backed by industry, not adopting it would alienate them. Fred: the problem here seems to be not alienating academia. Andrea mentions the Academic Alliance participants and the papers they have written. Need to point to research papers submitted, point to what is going on in France, what Imperial College did. Will put together a list.
- Discussion on CIMOMs and where they fit.
- Fred: do we develop a scenario, or put EM picture there and start discussing? Comments that we don't have clear-cut scenarios for EM. Fred: put EM picture up, submit a job to it, then follow where the resource model is used and how the data flow. Andrea, Ellen, Tom: looks OK. Fred to create an example of job to submit and get feedback.
- Tom Roney: What are the concerns? Fred: nomenclature, e.g. information vs. resource vs. data model. Ellen: any previous discussions in DMTF? Andrea: There is an IETF RFC that says that one is more generic than the other. Perhaps people are equating

data model and resource model, not resource and information model? CIM is information, not data model. Tom Maguire finds the RFC (3444), and finds that the RFC considers CIM a data model. Andrea: that's wrong.
